# Catechism **Q28**

## **How is Christ exalted?**

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

**Opening** - This is the final chapter in 1 Samuel. It is short and tragic. The realities and consequences of sin are terrible. Let this chapter drive us to the mercy and love of the righteous God.



**Bible reading - 1 Samuel 31**

Spend time praying, thinking back on all we've read in 1 Samuel.

In 1 Samuel, we read how God prepared David for the kingship; in 2 Samuel, we read of David as king. He ruled for forty years. 2 Samuel 1-5 tells how he became king over all Israel; 2 Samuel 6-10 of God's covenant with him, and his victories; 2 Samuel 11-12 of his fall into sin; and 2 Samuel 13-24 of his troubles in his declining years.
