Bible reading - 2 Samuel 2

Note that this was not a war between Israel and one of the pagan nations but within Israel itself, within the covenant community of God. It is analogous to warfare within the professing Church.

O Triune God, who commanded the universe, You have commanded us to ask for those things that concern your kingdom and our souls. Let us live and pray as one baptized into the threefold Name. Amen.
