Evening Family Worship Guide - 5pm

Opening - Read 1 Corinthians 10:12 and pray.



Bible reading - 2 Samuel 11

Notice that step by step David was drawn into sin, and step by step he attempts to cover his sin. Sin is like quicksand. The more David thrashes about, the worse the situation gets.

Discuss, as a family or with friends, why it can be hard to get out of sin once begun. Discuss the following saying - 'a shortcut always ends up the longest way.' If you have done something bad, even terrible, what is always the best course of action?

Remind each other that God is a God of forgiveness.

Read Psalm 51 together, especially verse 8. What is the connection of this Psalm to 2 Sam. 11? Is the superscript inspired? You can pray this Psalm in your own life.

let the bones you have crushed rejoice.*
